Program

Day 1: Arrival in Yerevan

Arrival at Zvartnots International Airport. After arrival procedures, meet your travel agency representative and transfer to the hotel (check-in at 15:00).

In case of early arrival, a visit to the Cascade Complex will be arranged for a first introduction to the city, followed by free time for coffee, beer, or relaxation until the rooms are ready.

Check-in at the hotel. Free time.

Dinner at a traditional restaurant with live music.

Overnight in Yerevan.

Day 2: Yerevan City Tour

Breakfast at the hotel. Full-day city tour of Yerevan, the capital of Armenia and one of the oldest cities in the world.

Departure for a visit to Victory Park and the Mother Armenia monument. The park also features interesting exhibits of Soviet military equipment, including a MiG-19.

Continue with a visit to the Matenadaran, one of the world's most important repositories of medieval manuscripts (closed on Sundays and Mondays).

Then enjoy a walking tour of the city center, including stops at the Opera and Ballet Theater (exterior), Swan Lake, Abovyan Street, Northern Avenue, and Republic Square.

Visit the Armenian Genocide Memorial at Tsitsernakaberd Hill, along with the museum, which presents historical evidence and personal testimonies, serving as a place of remembrance and education.

Next, visit the Ararat Brandy Factory, where you will learn about the history and production process of the famous Armenian brandy, followed by a guided tasting of two different varieties.

From there, continue to the local "Gum" Market, where you can discover authentic Armenian flavors and products.



Stroll among stalls filled with fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, cheeses, dried fruits, and nuts, enjoying the lively atmosphere and interaction with locals.

Finally, visit the Vernissage Market, the largest open-air market in Armenia, offering a wide variety of handmade items, artworks, traditional carpets, vintage coins, jewelry, and musical instruments. Today's tour becomes even more fun with classic Volga cars (1 car per 4 people). Have your cameras ready—this is a truly unique experience! Overnight in Yerevan.

Day 3: Yerevan – Khor Virap – Noravank – Yerevan – Wine Tasting

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to visit Khor Virap Monastery, where the majestic view of Mount Ararat is revealed. This is one of Armenia's most important pilgrimage sites, known for its deep spiritual significance and its dramatic location near the Turkish border. Continue to the Vayots Dzor Province, the country's most important wine-producing region. Drive through the beautiful Amaghou Valley and visit Noravank Monastery, one of Armenia's most famous monasteries, set within a spectacular landscape of red cliffs.



Next, we visit the Areni-1 Cave (Birds' Cave). In 2007, a 6,100-year-old winery was discovered here, along with a 5,500-year-old leather shoe – the oldest in the world – now exhibited at the History Museum of Armenia. The cave reveals a complete ancient winemaking system, including wine presses, fermentation vats, and storage vessels, demonstrating the significant role of wine in Armenian culture for millennia.

Stop at a local winery for a wine tasting, where you will sample 3 varieties (red, rosé, and white), accompanied by local cheeses and fruits.

Return to Yerevan. Overnight.



Day 4: Yerevan – Lake Sevan – Yerevan (240 km), Jeep 4x4 – Barbecue

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to visit Lake Sevan, the largest lake in Armenia and one of the largest high-altitude lakes in the world. Known as the “Blue Pearl” of Armenia, it impresses with its crystal-clear waters and breathtaking mountain scenery.

Visit to Sevanavank Monastery, built on a peninsula offering panoramic views of the lake and a serene atmosphere.

Then, departure to the village of Haghartsin, where you will board 4x4 Willys Jeeps for a unique off-road experience towards Mount Dimats, a hidden paradise for nature lovers and adventure seekers. The route offers stunning views of the rocky landscapes of the Ijevan Mountains.

The activity lasts approximately 4–5 hours, with the option to organize a picnic/barbecue at the top of the mountain.

Return to Yerevan. Overnight.

Day 5: Departure from Yerevan

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out.

Depending on your departure time, free time for shopping or visits, such as the Gold Market, Vernissage Market, or optional activities.

Transfer to Zvartnots International Airport for your departure flight.
