Program:

DAY 1 – Arrival & First Taste of the Black Sea

~11:00 Arrival at Kutaisi International Airport
Meet & greet followed by a scenic transfer to Batumi.

On the way: Lunch & Shekvetili Dendrological Park

We stop for lunch and a refreshing walk in the famous Dendrological Park of Shekvetili – a unique open-air collection of centuries-old trees brought from all over Georgia. Walking among giant magnolias, bamboo groves and exotic species by the sea feels calm, surprising, and very photogenic.

Evening Batumi City Tour

In the evening, Batumi truly comes alive. You'll see the famous dancing fountains, the romantic illuminated Ali & Nino moving sculpture, the Alphabetic Tower symbolizing the unique Georgian alphabet, and the lively seaside boulevard. A perfect first introduction to Georgia's modern Black Sea capital, full of lights, energy and seaside charm.

Overnight in Batumi

DAY 2 – Mountains, Waterfalls & Georgian Hospitality

Breakfast at the hotel

Enjoy Batumi at your own pace – relax on the beach, walk along the boulevard, or enjoy a coffee with sea views.





Machakhela Valley Excursion

In the afternoon, we head into the lush Machakhela Valley, known for its wild nature and deep mountain landscapes. You'll see beautiful waterfalls, ancient stone arch bridges, and traditional villages hidden among green hills – a side of Georgia untouched and authentic.

Dinner with a Local Family

The day ends with a heartfelt visit to a local family home. Enjoy a homemade Georgian dinner with breathtaking mountain views, while local children perform traditional Georgian folk dances. This is a warm, emotional experience that shows the true spirit of Georgian hospitality.

Overnight in Batumi

DAY 3 – Canyons, Caves & Kutaisi Heritage

Breakfast at the hotel and Transfer from Batumi to Kutaisi.

Martvili Canyon

Explore the emerald-green Martvili Canyon, where crystal-clear water, moss-covered cliffs and small waterfalls create a magical atmosphere. A short walk (and optional boat ride) makes this one of the most beautiful natural spots in Western Georgia.

Sataplia Nature Reserve

Visit Sataplia, famous for its ancient dinosaur footprints and panoramic viewpoints. From the glass platform, you'll enjoy stunning views over forests and the surrounding landscape, combining nature, history, and a touch of adventure.

Kutaisi City Tour

Discover Kutaisi, one of the oldest cities in Georgia. Visit the iconic Bagrati Cathedral – a UNESCO symbol of medieval Georgian architecture – and stroll around the central fountain area, feeling the relaxed, authentic rhythm of local life.

Overnight in Kutaisi

DAY 4 – Departure

Breakfast at the hotel (depending on flight time; if departure is very early, breakfast may not be available)

Transfer to Kutaisi International Airport.
