### Tour Program

#### Day 1: Arrival in Yerevan - City tour

Arrival in Yerevan by Wizz Air in the morning. After airport formalities, meet your guide and transfer to the city. Check-in at the hotel.

We begin with a walking tour of the Cascade Complex, home to the Sculpture Park and the Cafesjian Center for the Arts. The program continues with a stroll through the city center, including stops at the Opera and Ballet Theater (exterior), Swan Lake, Abovyan Street, Northern Avenue, and Republic Square.

In the late afternoon, visit Vernissage Market, the largest open-air market in Armenia. Established by artists in the 1980s, it offers a wide variety of items such as wood carvings, artworks, traditional carpets, vintage coins and medallions, books, jewelry, and musical instruments. Visit the Genocide Memorial & Museum.

The day concludes with a 1.5-hour panoramic tour in retro Volga cars (3 passengers per vehicle), with a stop at Yerevan Central Station to view the famous monument of Sasuntsi David.

Finally, visit Victory Park and the Mother Armenia monument.

#### Day 2: Yerevan – Khor Virap – Areni-1 – Noravank – Yerevan

In the morning, departure to visit the Khor Virap Monastery, where the majestic Mount Ararat reveals its breathtaking beauty and grandeur. It is one of Armenia's most important pilgrimage sites, known for its deep spiritual significance and its dramatic location near the Turkish border.

Khor Virap is famous as the place where Saint Gregory the Illuminator was imprisoned for 13 years in an underground pit before emerging to lead the Christianization of Armenia in 301 AD. The monastery's location offers one of the most iconic and unobstructed views of biblical Mount Ararat, making it a perfect spot for photography and reflection.

Next, visit the Areni-1 Cave (Birds' Cave). In 2007, Armenian and Irish archaeologists discovered here a 6,100-year-old winery and a 5,500-year-old leather shoe – the oldest leather footwear in the world – now exhibited at the History Museum of Armenia.



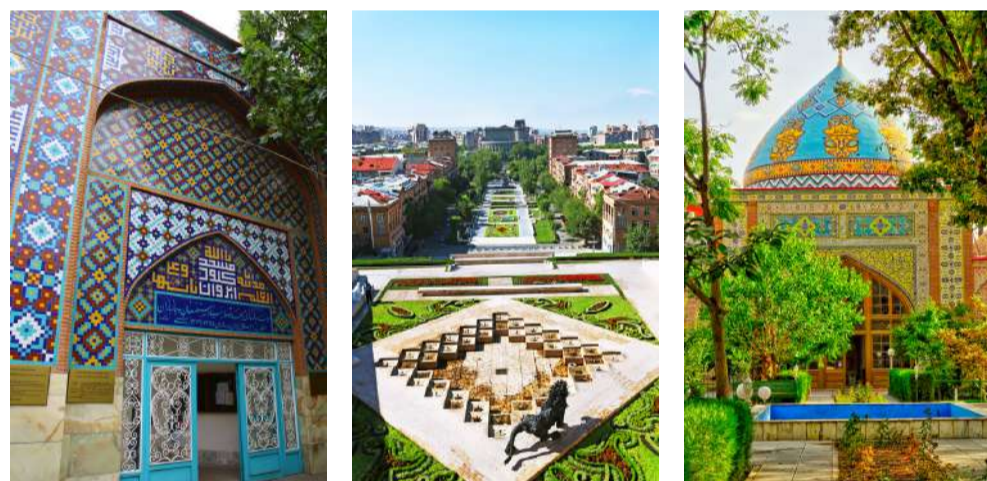
The cave reveals a complete ancient winemaking system, including grape presses, fermentation vats, and storage vessels, while chemical traces of wine have been identified in ceramic findings. This site highlights the central role of wine in Armenian culture for millennia. A guided tour follows, offering insight into Armenia's ancient winemaking tradition.

**Day 3: Yerevan - Free day**

Free day in Yerevan for personal activities, прогулки, shopping, or relaxation.

After check-out from the hotel, transfer to Zvartnots Airport for the departure flight at 05:30 am.
