### DAY 1: LARNACA - NICE

Meet at the airport and depart for the cosmopolitan city of Nice, with a connection flight. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.

Nice is perhaps the most vibrant of the cities along the French Riviera, boasting classic landmarks such as the Promenade des Anglais and its beautiful Old Town, renowned for its open-air flower markets and countless antique shops.

### DAY 2: NICE - SAINT-PAUL-DE-VENTE

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by a guided tour of the cosmopolitan city of Nice, considered one of the oldest settlements in Europe and named in honor of the goddess Nike. The city's famous Promenade des Anglais stretches along the seafront and takes its name from a group of English aristocrats who frequented the area in the 18th century. During the tour you will see the iconic Hotel Negresco, the city's main square, Place Masséna with the statue of Neptune, Place Garibaldi, and finally the Nice Cathedral.

Continuation to one of the most picturesque villages in the region, Saint-Paul-de-Vence, surrounded by the walls built during the reign of Francis I and renowned as a haven for painters and artists. Free time for lunch. Return to our hotel in Nice. In the evening, we suggest an excursion to Monte Carlo, home to the world-famous Casino. Try your luck in its glittering halls, completed under the architectural supervision of Charles Garnier. If gaming is not to your taste, enjoy a drink or dinner accompanied by live music at the bar of Café de Paris. You may also sample a Kir Royal at Le Bar Américain in the salons of the Hotel de Paris and dance to the rhythms of the Buddha Bar. Late return to the hotel. Overnight stay.

### DAY 3: NICE - MONTE CARLO

Breakfast and departure for the small Principality of Monaco. There is the option to ascend by elevators to the top of the hill, next to the Jacques-Yves Cousteau Oceanographic Museum (optional entrance), and to visit the Exotic Gardens. This is followed by an exterior visit to the Grimaldi Palace, with the possibility of witnessing the changing of the guard. The journey then continues to Menton, the "Pearl of the French Riviera." As you approach, the pastel-colored buildings, the harmonious blend of Italian finesse and French elegance, and the shimmering sea create a truly enchanting setting. A walk through the Old Town, with its narrow alleys and stairways leading up to the Cathedral of Saint Michael, offers breathtaking views of the Mediterranean and an atmosphere of authentic charm. Return to Nice. Overnight.

### DAY 4: NICE - CANNES - ANTIBES

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Antibes (ancient Antipolis), where a guided walk through the town's picturesque narrow streets follows. During the stroll, visitors will see the traditional market, the Picasso Museum (external visit), the house of Nikos Kazantzakis (external visit), as well as former guild workshops and the Archaeological Museum (external visit), featuring Greco-

Roman artifacts.

The excursion then continues to Cannes, along the famous La Croisette, one of the most iconic boulevards in Europe. Here you will admire impressive buildings and luxury hotels dating from the Belle Époque, as well as the Palais des Festivals. Free time for coffee, a walk, and lunch. Afterwards, departure for Grasse, the world capital of perfumery. Visit to one of the city's renowned perfume factories, where the process of perfume creation is presented, from distillation to composition. There is also the opportunity to take part in a short workshop to create your own personal fragrance. Return to Nice in the late afternoon. Overnight stay.

### DAY 5: NICE

A free day at leisure to enjoy walks, shopping, or relaxation on the city beach. We suggest an optional excursion to Port Grimaud and Saint-Tropez. Port Grimaud is a unique seaside village in southern France, located on the Gulf of Saint-Tropez. It is often referred to as the "Little Venice of Provence," as it is built around an intricate network of canals. Saint-Tropez is one of the most famous resorts of the French Riviera and a symbol of luxury and cosmopolitan lifestyle. Originally a small fishing village, it rose to worldwide fame during the 1950s. Overnight.

### DAY 6: NICE - LARNACA

Breakfast at leisure. In the afternoon, transfer to the airport for your return flight to Larnaca, with an intermediate stop.
