**Program:**

**DAY 1, 01/11: Arrival in Cairo – Citadel – Lunch**

Welcome to Cairo. After the welcome, our representatives will assist you with the visa issuance procedures and then transfer you directly for a visit to the Citadel of Cairo for a guided tour with a local English-speaking Egyptologist. Stop for lunch at a selected restaurant (Sky Rim Restaurant). Transfer to your hotel for check-in.

**DAY 2, 02/11: Pyramids & Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM)**

Right after breakfast, your Egyptologist guide will meet you for a visit to the Pyramids. You will see the Great Pyramid, a royal tomb, and the Sphinx. Optionally, you may enjoy a camel ride, followed by return to the city of Cairo where we will visit the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM).





Before the guided tour, refresh yourself while enjoying your meal at one of the most popular restaurants within the Museum premises. The Grand Egyptian Museum is designed to present the largest and most comprehensive collection dedicated to ancient Egyptian civilization. The museum preserves, exhibits, and studies over 50,000 artifacts covering 7,000 years of history. It embraces the diversity of Egyptian heritage and connects visitors with knowledge, creativity, culture, and the future.



### **DAY 3, 03/11: Christian Cairo**

The day begins with breakfast and immediately afterwards, a walk through Old – Christian Cairo. During a short tour, we will see, among other sites, the Church of Saint George, a landmark for Greeks and Christians of Egypt, as well as the Church of Saints Sergius and Bacchus, located in the area where it is believed that the Holy Family stayed when they fled to Egypt. Next, we will visit the Hanging Church, the most famous Coptic Christian church in Cairo. Lunch at a selected restaurant. If time permits, transfer and free time at the Khan El Khalili Bazaar to experience the local atmosphere.

### **DAY 4, 4 /11: National Museum of Egyptian Civilization – Flight to Aswan – Philae, High Dam, Kom Ombo**

After breakfast and before our flight to Aswan, we will stop for a short visit to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, where 22 Royal Mummies are preserved. Arrival at Aswan Airport. You will begin with a visit to the High Dam and the Granite Quarries. Then, transfer by small motorboat to the Temple of Philae on Agilka Island. The temple was dedicated to Isis, sister/wife of Osiris and patroness of the Ptolemaic period. This is followed by a ride on a traditional felucca along the Nile. Transfer to the cruise ship for check-in and lunch.

### **DAY 5, 05/11: Optional Abu Simbel – Kom Ombo**

Early in the morning, optional excursion to Abu Simbel and visit to the impressive temples.

In the afternoon, lunch and sailing to Kom Ombo. Visit the Temple of Sobek, dedicated to the crocodile-headed god, god of fertility and creator of the world. The temple stands at a bend in the Nile, where in ancient times sacred crocodiles basked along the riverbanks.

Return to the cruise ship and sail to Edfu.

Overnight on board.

#### **DAY 6, 06/11: Nile Cruise – Edfu – Luxor**

Early in the morning and before breakfast, transfer by horse-drawn carriage to visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu, the largest and best-preserved temple along the Nile. Horus, also known as Haroeris, was the falcon-headed solar god of war. Return to the ship and sail to Esna. Cross the Esna lock. Arrival in Luxor and visit the impressive Temple of Luxor, built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II for rituals and festivals, dedicated to the god Amun.

Return to the cruise ship, dinner and overnight on board.

#### **DAY 7, 07/11: Luxor – East Bank (Karnak) – West Bank (Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut, Memnon) – Luxor**

After breakfast, disembarkation and visit to the Temple of Karnak, also known as the “Temple of Temples”, the largest religious complex ever built. The impressive Hypostyle Hall is a “forest” of giant columns, larger even than Notre Dame Cathedral.

Then cross to the West Bank of the Nile and visit the magnificent Valley of the Kings, a vast ancient burial ground where the tombs of 62 pharaohs have been discovered. The tombs are carved deep into the rock and decorated with impressive scenes and treasures for the afterlife.

Next, visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a unique architectural masterpiece rising in successive terraces from the desert landscape.

On the way back, stop at the famous Colossi of Memnon, two impressive statues approximately 20 meters high of Amenhotep III.

Transfer to the hotel in Luxor and overnight.

#### **DAY 8, 8/11: Transfer to the airport and flight to Larnaca via Cairo**
